EV VEHICLE SAFETY: AN AWARENESS LEVEL TRAINING

This course is designed and intended to give first responders - Fire, EMS, Law Enforcement, & Towing/Recovery - core knowledge for safely and effectively dealing with fire and non-fire incidents involving hybrid and electric vehicles. Topics to be covered include types of hybrid and electric vehicles - from personal scooters to commercial vehicles; key vehicle components; response hazards; strategies and tactics for dealing with incidents involving these vehicles; IDENTIFY - IMMOBILIZE - DISABLE; impact on control zones and "quick clearance"; and after incident considerations. Key information will be provided in handouts.

This class is offered free of charge for the Ohio Fire Service. Although the class is free, you must register to attend. Because of security at the NASA facility, all attendees must be preregistered. No walk-ins will be admitted.
